Easter Chick Knitting Pattern



Materials:

- Double knit or Aran
- Size 10 needles (3.25mm)

Method:

1. Cast on 24 stitches and knit 2 rows. Increase 1 stitch at the beginning of every row until 36 stitches are on the needle.
2. Knit further 2 rows and cast off 11 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows, making 14 stitches.
3. Knit 12 rows
4. Knit 2 together across the row. Cut off wool about 12 inches long.
5. Decorate the chick with two eyes and a felt beak before sewing together.
6. Using a darning needle draw through 7 stitches. With the remainder of the wool sew the chick. Leave a space on the underside of the chick to insert the chocolate egg.
